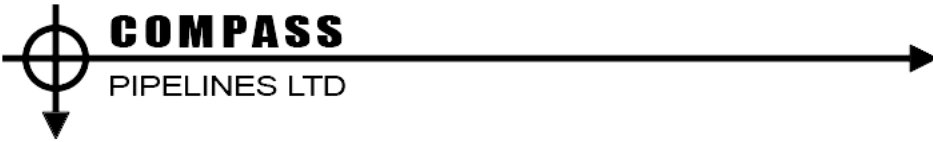
CRITERIA FOR FULL ENTRY
